

Results of the second AVEO Survey

8th Letter to Residents
August 2016

The AVEO Working Group (AWG) has recently asked residents to indicate whether they supported the current AVEO proposal to construct Independent Living Units (ILU) and a Residential Aged Care Facility (RACF) on the land it purchased in 2014. The Survey followed almost a year of negotiation with AVEO and a two-week shop front, which AVEO provided for lot owners in the village last month.

348 lot owners, of a total of 1276 eligible votes, responded with 44% in favour and 56% against.

The AWG thanks all those who responded although we are a little disappointed that 73% of Sanctuary Cove lot owners (excluding Mulpha-owned lots) did not express their view on this important development.

As mentioned in our last letter, the results of the survey will be forwarded to the PBC, PTBC, the State government and the local state member.

It is now up to AVEO and the PBC to determine the next steps.

If AVEO goes ahead, lot owners will have other opportunities through their RBCs and the PBC to make comments and will have the opportunity to correspond directly with the Minister.

As Chair of the AWG, I have indicated previously that I, or any other member of the Group, is prepared to attend RBC meetings to provide details of the proposal and answer questions; that offer remains.

The AWG's work is now complete. We thank all those lot owners who have assisted the Group over the past 12 months.
